

A is for apple, juicy and red,

Snap, snap, snap, by the riverside!










B is for butterfly, colourful and bright,

Roaring in the forest all day long!









C is for cat, soft and furry,

Vroom, vroom, vroom, with its engine's beat!








E is for elephant, enormous and grey,

Crack it open, a chick takes flight!












F is for frog, hopping with glee,


G is for giraffe, tall and grand,

Yawning and splashing, it always suggests!





In the garden, it takes flight!









J is for jellyfish, floating in the sea,

Bounce and leap, it's a fun show!






K is for kite, soaring up high,

In the open fields, it finds its space!






L is for lion, majestic and strong,


M is for Moon, shining so bright,






O is for octopus, in the deep sea,

Chirping and squawking, a delightful sight!



In the grassy meadows, where it'll stay!






R is for rainbow, a colourful arc,  
Painting the sky, leaving its mark.



R for rabbit, hopping so fast,  
Through fields and forests, a sprint that'll last!





# Ss


T is for tiger, with stripes so bold,



U is for unicorn, magical and rare,

# Vv




V is for volcano, erupting with might,

Strings vibrating, under the crescent moon!






W is for whale, giant of the sea,


X is for xylophone, notes in a row,

# Yy




Y is for yacht, sailing the ocean blue,
